THE ROLE:

Reporting to the Commercial Manager, you will join the team of Contract Surveyors managing commercial aspects of projects. You will control and manage costs, identify opportunities for increasing profit margins and promote the core values of the business.

- To undertake the day to day commercial/surveying activities of allocated projects.

- Strong IT skills.
- Numerate and accurate in your work.

- Ideally have at least 5 years construction experience in a Contracting QS role.
- The initial projects will be the delivery of affordable housing, therefore prior experience working on similar types of projects would be an advantage, but not essential.
