- Investigation of new technologies in regard to mechanical and electrical installations.
- Ensure the production of "as built" and O&M information at project completion.
- Obtaining, collating and distributing design risk assessments/information from project consultants and designing contractors to meet CDM obligations.
- Assessing design risk and providing information as required for health and safety to meet current Construction Design and Management (CDM) legislation.
- Managing design and technical queries raised by Construction staff / Contractors / Maintenance Staff as required

## SKILLS/QUALIFICATIONS/EXPERIENCE:

- Extensive residential and commercial project experience.
- Services engineering Degree or equivalent (HND/ONC in Electrical or Mechanical Engineering).
- A design and build contracting background in mechanical with main contractor experience preferred.
- Good working knowledge of Building Regulations and standards relating to M&E, SAP/SBEM, BREEAM, Energy and Sustainability including zero and low carbon solutions.
