THE ROLE:

DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITY:

- Setting out for roads and parking, drainage, building substructure and superstructure, and all related calculations.
- Horizontal and vertical control of structures all aspects of substructure and superstructure.
- As-built surveys
- The keeping of both written and digital records
- Travel to sites throughout Scotland
- Undertaking professional development when deemed necessary.
- Work closely with Site Management Teams to ensure compliance with construction issue drawings and information.
- Carry out drawing reviews and clash detection with the Site Management Teams.
- Liaise with Customer, Clients & Design Teams to ensure the correct information is available in sufficient time.
- Be aware of construction programmes to ensure setting out is planned in advance.
- Comply with the requirements of the companies quality procedures.
- All other duties as assigned to effectively carry out your role.

SKILLS/QUALIFICATIONS/EXPERIENCE:

- Ideally possess a degree in Civil Engineering and or qualified in a suitable construction discipline.
- Experienced in both groundworks and superstructure setting out.
- Proficient in the use of a robotic total station (Trimble or equivalent).
- Demonstrated competence in reading and crosschecking drawings both engineering and architectural.
- A sound knowledge of the construction process is essential along with experience in a similar role with a major contractor.
- Experience of Topographic surveying would be an asset but is not essential.
- As-built surveys.
- Experience with AutoCAD (or other Autodesk products) would be an advantage but is not essential.
- Excellent computer literacy in Microsoft Office is essential.
- The candidate needs to demonstrate sufficient abilities to accomplish daily targets on major general construction sites throughout Scotland.

Full clean driving licence is essential.
