

Plumbing & Heating Surveyor

MAIN PURPOSE OF THE ROLE:

Reporting to the Plumbing Manager you will be responsible for managing financial and contractual performance of building contracts from pre-commencement through to final account agreement including completing and submitting tenders.

DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Reviewing tender information including pricing, sub-contractors quotes, preliminaries and contract conditions.
- Reviewing internal contract preliminary requirements and preparing spend budgets/cost forecasts.
- Preparation of cash flow reports as part of monthly board report.
- Advising on contract requirements and managing project risks in conjunction with the project team.
- · Responsible for managing target prices for plumbers.
- Responsible for managing and liaison with the Employers quantity surveyor.
- Responsible for reparation of, submission and agreement of main contract interim valuations.
- Provide support and advice to administration/accounts staff on any monies due, the dates when monies become due, and provide support in collection of monies as and when required.
- Responsibility for re-measurement of the works, for main contract, sub-contractor valuations and in-house operations.
- Responsibility for sub-contractor payment applications, payments, payment and withholding notices in line with protocols
- Working with Plumbing Manager/Contracts Supervisor to complete tenders.
- Providing contract advice to the site team, advising on obligations of main contract and preparation of any/all formal notices as required/agreed with the team.
- Managing project financial control, including preparation of cost projections, managing cash flow and preparing end projection forecasts.
- Preparation of financial reports for monthly meetings with accounts team.
- Managing agreement of final accounts with sub-contractors.
- Any other tasks as may be allocated from time to time.

SKILLS/QUALIFICATIONS:

- Demonstrate knowledge of interim and final contract valuations.
- Proficient with Excel spreadsheets and Microsoft office.

Desirable

- Degree qualified in an appropriate discipline.
- Considerable plumbing experience.
- Knowledge of both plumbing and heating systems.
- Experience with plumbing/heating bills of quantities.
